



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

PE Program Course Work

- Enroll in Seminar (PTP, Congregational Seminar, Workshop, Webinar, School of Preaching).
- Use the methods taught. Have someone in your home, attempt a Bible study, write a report on it.

Master's Level Course Work

- Enroll in Seminar (PTP, Congregational Seminar, Workshop, Webinar).
- Training on Back to the Bible (completed program at a school of preaching).
- Use the methods taught. Have someone in your home, attempt a Bible study, write a report on it.
- Watch additional lessons provided by Rob.
- Work through five methods of evangelism (*Searching for Truth*, Jule Miller VBSS, Open Bible Study, Evangelism Made Simple). Write a short paragraph on strengths, weaknesses, and how each can be used.
- Teach someone at your congregation how to use one of the tools. Write a short report.

SCHEDULE (PE Program)

Let's Adopt the Right Mind-set: In this special ladies' session, Nicole deals with common questions and shares the pivotal role they have in soul winning (ladies only).

Let's Make the Application: I sit down with elders, preachers, and deacons and provide practical suggestions on how to implement this program and train members.

SCHEDULE (Master's Level Program)

Back to the Authority of the Bible: Based on lesson one, we will focus on the authority of Christ and the difference between the Old and New Testaments.

Back to the Church of the Bible: Based on lesson two, we will focus on the origin, organization, worship, and name of the church.

Back to the Salvation in the Bible: Based on lesson three, we will focus on sin, salvation, and commitment.
